



Malbec 2014

This Mediterranean cultivar grows very well in South Africa. The Malbec grapes is from a trellised vineyard in Stellenbosch. The vineyard received supplementary irrigation through a drip system only when necessary. After crushing, the juice remained on the skins for 24 hours. Fermentation took place in small barrels. After malolactic fermentation, the wine was matured in French oak casks.

Dark ruby with floral and violet fragrances, spice and dark chocolate aromas. Rich and full with berry and plum flavours with soft tannins.

Our seasoned winemaker, Andries Blake has 23 years of wine making experience and this enabled him to select the best grapes for the Blake Boys' Malbec.

This young, fruity all-rounder will be the perfect match for a meal of slow cooked lamb shank, smokey cured beef or dishes with a plum compote. It will partner both red and white meat dishes.
