

Chenin Blanc 2021

Single Vineyard

Chenin Blanc is the winemaker, Andries Blake's favourite white varietal. The wine is produced from a single vineyard dryland bush vine in the Swartland.

Golden hued and full-bodied with dried apricot, vanilla and honey on the nose. 70% of the Chenin Blanc is fermented in stainless steel tanks and 30% is fermented in French oak. Harmonious balance between fruit and oak flavours. The wood adds to the mouth feel of the wine.

This well structured wine have sufficient body to enhance spicy and full flavoured meals. Also partners well with mild seafood and poultry
