

Malbec 2023

Single Vineyard

This popular Mediterranean cultivar grows very well in South Africa. The Malbec grapes were sourced from a farm close to the coast in Philadelphia.

The grapes were hand-picked in the early morning and cooled down. Fermentation took place in small stainless steel tanks. After malolactic fermentation, the wine was matured in French oak barrels.

A deep velvet red with a touch of garnet on the rim. A rich and full wine with soft tannins. Good mouth feel with vibrant aromas of mocha and dark chocolate
