16MILE Beach is the longest uninterrupted beach in South Africa. This unspoilt stretch of beach is in the small West Coast village of Yzerfontein – home of Blake Family Wines.

Blake Family Wines paid homage by naming their lifestyle range after this beach. The range consist of 3 wines – a red blend, a white blend and a rosè.

Swemgat is a natural rock pool in Yzerfontein. It is very popular, due to its safety and the fact that the water is a tad warmer than the open ocean of the Atlantic Coast.

This fruit driven dry white wine is a blend of Sauvignon Blanc and Chenin Blanc. This wine has an abundance of fruit flavours on the nose - green figs of the Sauvignon Blanc and tropical flavours of the Chenin Blanc.

Partners well with roast pork & chicken.
