Pinot Noir 2025

The grapes for the Blake's Pinot Noir derives from Ebenhaezer, a small fishing village located at the mouth of the Olifants River. The vineyard belong to the local community and forms part of a BEE project.

After fermentation the wine has been wood matured in 2nd and 3rd fill French barrels.

This light bodied Pinot Noir has notes of red fruits like strawberry, cherry and raspberry on the nose.

Silky, soft tannins and a food-friendly, easy to drink wine.

Partners well with a variety of food from Salmon or seafood pasta to light red meat dishes or soft cheeses like brie or camembert.
